Directions to Recreation Game Fields

ZOAR BAPTIST CHURCH - U6 Games

Go to Shelby High School and Walgreens, turn left onto DeKalb Street towards Boiling Springs.

Turn right at light onto LaFayette Street. Zoar Baptist Church will be on your left.

Fields will be down behind the church on the baseball field.

Piedmont Park in Lawndale U6 Games

18 North to light in Fallston

Turn left onto Hwy 182 or Stagecoach Road and go until you see

Lawndale City Limit sign and park is just after bank on right. Can't miss it!

OR— Take Hwy 226 North to light in Polkville.

Turn right onto Hwy 182 or Stagecoach Road. Travel to Lawndale and thru downtown. Park is on the left.

DAVIDSON PARK in Kings Mountain

From 74 Bypass traveling East- exit Oak Grove/Waco Rd. Turn Right onto Waco Rd. Turn Right onto N. Simms St. Turn Right into parking lot at Davidson Park

From 74 Bypass traveling West- exit Oak Grove/Waco Rd.

Turn Left onto Waco Rd. Turn Right onto N. Simms St. Turn Right into parking lot at Davidson Park

Gardner Webb

Hwy 74 to Shelby High School & Walgreens turn left onto DeKalb Street/Hwy 150. Continue on Hwy 150 quite a ways – and when you come to the second traffic light (downtown Boiling Springs), turn left.

Continue to Hardees and turn right into Gardner Webb campus and soccer fields will be straight in front of you.
